FAST Overview

In March 2022, Governor Ron DeSantis signed new legislation that replaces the Florida Standards Assessment (FSA) in English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics with the Coordinated Screening and Progress Monitoring System also called the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST), required in section 1008.25(8) Florida Statutes. This fact sheet provides an overview of the new FAST system for grades 3-10 ELA Reading and grades 3-
