A 16 or 17 year old student may elect to dropout of school only after the student and parent have an exit interview with either the guidance counselor or school social worker. This process accomplishes three goals; to see if other alternatives to dropping out are available to the student, to identify the reasons the student is choosing to quit school and to ensure everyone's awareness of the driver's license law and other issues related to dropping out of school.
