This policy allows students to reflect antheir performance, identify areas for improvement, and strive for mastery of course content. It's essential to note that this apportunity is not extended to essays or projects that involve rough drafts or progress checkpoints, as these assignments already provide ample apportunity for revision and feedback. Students have one week from the date of receiving their graded test to initiate the repair process. Repair sessions may be scheduled before or after school, but not during regular class time. Additionally, students have the option to complete their repairs under the supervision of a proctor in the media center during tutoring sessions. Upon successful completion of the repair; students will earn points at the discretion of the teacher. This provides a tangible incentive for engagement in the improvement process and reinforces the value of orguing learning and gowth
